Penguin Punch Art

If you love these little guys as much as I do, you'll be surprised at how simple they are to make.

You'll need the Stampin'Up! Owl Builder Punch, paper snips, & liquid glue. The paper is Whisper White, Basic Black & Pumpkin Pie cardstock.







To make each penguin, you will need 2 owl bodies in Basic Black, 1 owl body in Pumpkin Pie, 1 vest in Whisper White, 2 large eyes in white, 2 small eyes in black & 1 heart in Pumpkin Pie.



Begin by cutting the Pumpkin Pie body so that only the lower third is left. You only need the feet from this part.



Next, cut the feet and ears off of oval or pear shape.
Cut the other body so only the to create the penguin wings.

one black body so you are left with an upper third is left. You will use this piece



The wings are made by following the curve of the ears and cutting as shown below. You can discard the middle piece. (They look a little like shark fins, don't they?)

Next adhere the Pumpkin Pie feet behind the Penguin body.

The wings will be adhered to the back of the body. Here is your view from front and back.







When you add the vest, make sure to leave a little bit of black showing at the bottom edge. The heart is used as the beak. Let the bottom point of the heart overlap onto the white vest. Don't worry, the eyes will cover the upper part of the heart.



If you adhere the black pupil directly in the center of the white eye, your penguin will always look like he is staring straight ahead. Glue them off center, and you can make you penguin look in whatever direction you want. Just be sure you don't have both eyes facing in towards each other or he'll look cross eyed!

See how cute he is when he is all finished?
