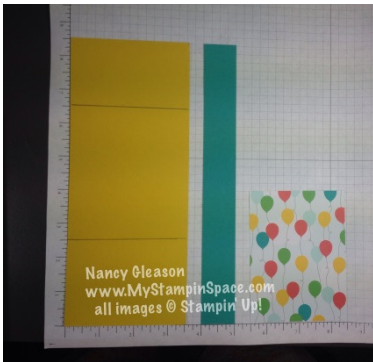


# Gift Card Holder



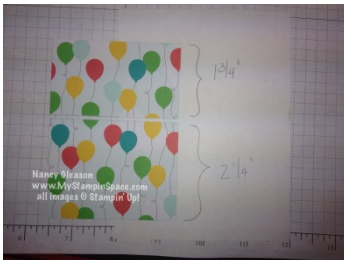
## **Paper:**

- Cut a piece of Cardstock to 3-1/2" wide x 8-1/2" high – (You will get 3 from 1 sheet of paper – great if you need to make several!)
- Score this piece at 2-1/2" and at 6-1/2". Use the corner rounder punch if desired, on the top corners only!
- Fold the bottom section up at the score line and adhere bottom section with a thin line of Mono glue along outer edge only to create gift card pocket.
- Create a belly band from Card Stock at approx. 1 to 1-1/2" wide. Score this at 2-1/2" and wrap around closed gift card holder. Glue band to itself.

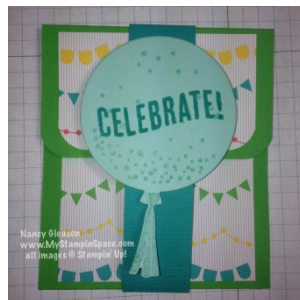


**Cut a piece of DSP to 3-1/4" wide x 4"; then cut at 2-1/4" so you have 2 pieces: 3-1/4" W x 2-1/4"H and 3-1/4" W x 1-3/4" H**

**Glue the DSP to the gift card holder (if you corner rounded the top flap, corner round the bottom corner of the top section of DSP before adhering!)**



**Embellish your belly band with whatever shape, buttons, to decorate as needed for the occasion!**



(TIP: I used the 6" x 6" *Cherry on Top DSP paper stack* for this project. To maximize yield, I cut my DSP to 3" wide – rather than 3-1/4")

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
